


A quick 3 step guide to measuring a spot heating project


Measure, record, submit.





Measuring the area you are looking to heat

This section focuses on spot heating a desk/packing area that is next to a wall. To quote an area like this, all we require is the dimensions of the area that is occupied by a person (red lines) and the depth of the bench/table (green line)



Rule of thumb, we usually calculate 'occupied areas' with a worker standing a meter away from the edge of the bench



Measuring the area you are looking to heat

This section focusses on heating a free standing work station which could be situated within a larger unheated area. Again we will need the dimensions of the occupied area (red lines) and the dimensions of the work station (green lines)

Measurements required (Length and width of area occupied by worker)

Rule of thumb, we usually calculate occupied areas with a worker standing a meter away from the edge of the bench



Recording your measurements

Once submitted, we'll will use your measurements to work out how many kW your project requires and which heaters are most suitable. It is vital the measurements are as accurate as possible.


Here's an examples of how we record the measurements of a spot eating project. We would recommend following this.

This is the most simple way to record your measurements and gives us all the info we need

An idea of any anomalies that might effect our specification is always very handy

Sending a dimensioned sketch is again very handy for our design team

Emailing an image of your work station allows us to get a much better understanding of your project





Submitting your measurements
